

A refraction is a measurement that determines the best vision your eyes have, it is necessary if you would like to have a new glasses prescription or contact lenses, or if you have had a change in your vision. Determining your best vision is the only way to begin an evaluation of your eye health, so we will check your vision with your glasses.

Medicare and other forms of insurance do not consider a refraction to be part of a comprehensive eye exam. Medicare will not pay for this service. Regular insurance usually does not cover this service. However, Medicare and regular insurance allows us to charge and be paid for this service. The charge for a refraction is \$71.00.
